How this unit will build on what you already know:

This 'Holidays and Hobbies' unit will build on what you already know by adding to your vocabulary key words related to holidays, weather and seasons, sports and hobbies.

You will gain further understanding of specific vocabulary of how to say what the weather is like, temperatures, names of different sports and hobbies. You will then progress on to key phrases connected to the themes.


What you will learn:

- To listen and respond to topic vocabulary;
- To answer questions orally using the topic vocabulary;
- To write an answer in a sentence using the topic vocabulary;
- To present ideas and information orally to a range of audiences.
- To choose the correct preposition: en for feminine countries, au for masculine countries;
- To choose whether the mode of transport needs en or à.
