

English

This term in English we will be developing our writing skills using the books 'The Troll Swap' and 'The Owl Who Was Afraid of the dark'. In our guided reading sessions, the Year 2s will be reading 'The Troll' and 'Above and Below'. The Year 1s will follow the guided reading in the Rising Stars Phonics scheme.

PSHE

We will be learning about relationships. We will think about families and friendships, safe relationships and respecting ourselves and others.

PE

We will be developing our fitness through circuit training and practicing our bat and ball skills through multisport activities.

Art, Design & Technology

In Art, we will be colour mixing and sketching to create some 'Bonfire art' with a focus on the artist 'Picasso'

In Design & Technology, we will be learning about slider and lever mechanisms to make our own moving picture cards.

Maths

This term in Maths the Year 1s will be learning about place value (within 10), addition and subtraction (within 10) and shape. The Year 2s will be learning about place value (within 100), addition and subtraction (within 100) and shape.

Geography

This term we will be developing our geographical skills by learning about the North and South Pole. We will find out about the Arctic and Antarctic regions, we will learn about the climate and wildlife of each and find similarities and differences between them, we will begin to understand what climate change is and how it is affecting these regions of the Earth.

Computing

We will be learning about technology around us and will be thinking about how to manage information online

Science

This term in Science we will be learning about Animals. We will identify familiar mammals and described their basic structure, look at birds and explore their needs for survival, look at fish and their specific needs for survival, identify and name common examples of amphibians before looking at their needs for survival.

Music

Mrs Kessel-Fell will be teaching us to get musical with weather sounds and celebration music.

History

This term we will be looking at The Great Fire of London. We will talk about events that have happened in our past, we will compare present day London with London in the past, we will think about what life was like in London in 1666, we will think about how and why the fire spread so quickly and compare what would be done differently in the present day

RE

We will be learning about Christianity. We will be thinking about the question 'What do Christians believe God is like?' and 'Why does Christmas matter to Christians?'
